What is upgrading and does post-secondary fund it?

- Means that all your basic classes starting from Grade 9 need to be at a 30 level, so therefore you will have to re-take the required classes in order to be accepted into your program.
- Post-secondary DOES NOT FUND Academic upgrading

Researching your program

- Students need to be aware that their programs will be intense and you will be handling 101 different assignments and readings. So please DO YOUR RESEARCH. As we want you to succeed and not be set up to fail.
- Have a career plan, we do not want students to be changing their major in the middle of each semester as it does affect your funding in the long run. Once you start your major stick with it.

Due diligence and Communication

- Students are Responsible to attend class on their own and to be independent once they are in University/college
- Students are also Responsible to keep clear communication with their funders, we want to know how your studies are going and how are you doing mentally and emotionally as University/ College life can be overwhelming, if we do not hear from the student throughout the whole semester we will contact the university to check in. If you are doing poorly and have not contacted Bearspaw Post-Secondary, your allowance will be withheld until you contacted the Bearspaw Post-secondary Coordinator.
- NO 3rd party pickups or please refrain from sending family members on your behalf to meet with post-secondary

Respect and privacy

- We also want to enquire that students need to be respectful to the post-secondary staff, **WE DO NOT TOLERATE ANY FORM OF ABUSE** whether it's the student or family member. **"Give respect to gain respect"**

and if you send an email after hours your email will be answered the next business day.

- We also advised that students keep the info between post-secondary and themselves **CONFIDENTIAL**. Also how much they get in allowance must be confidential as well. As it's YOUR Allowance for school.
