NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

BEARSPAW FIRST NATION ELECTION REGULATIONS – REFERENDUM VOTE

TAKE NOTICE THAT, on September 26, 2025 a vote will be held by secret ballot to determine if a majority of electors of the Bears paw First Nation are in favor of approving a Bears paw First Nation Election Regulations.

Eligible voters (“Electors”) are members of Bears paw First Nation who are least 21 years of age on the date of the referendum, which is on September 26, 2025.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT the question to be submitted to the Electors is as follows:

“As an Elector are you in favor of approving the proposed 2025 Bears paw Custom Election Regulations for the November 2025 General Election?”

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT the referendum will be held on Friday, September 20, 2025 and the electors may vote in-person at one of the two polling stations located at:
